

Supply List for **Applique the Easy Way**

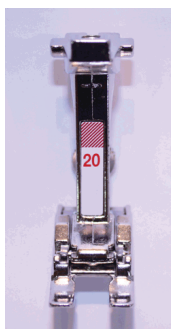

- Sewing Machine in good working order (*You must know how to thread your machine, wind a bobbin, and choose stitches on your machine. If you think you may have any questions regarding your machine, please bring your manual.*)
- Open toed applique foot (*See photo below*)
- Bobbins
- Thread in colors to match your fabrics
- Applique Press Sheet (*This is a MUST. It will make your applique process so much easier.*)
- Pen or pencil
- Scissors for paper and fabric
- Heat 'n Bond Lite fusible web - at least one yard
- Extension tray for your machine (*if you have one*)
- White computer paper for stabilizer (*approximately 5-6 sheets*)
- Pattern of your choice by **Hissyfitz Designs**



You have the option to choose any pattern from **Hissyfitz Designs** as your project for this workshop. If you plan to make a full quilt or wallhanging, please refer to fabric yardage on the pattern you choose. If you are only going to do one block of the pattern, you can get by with a smaller amount of yardage. Patterns may be ordered from my website, www.HissyfitzDesigns.com.
