Optional partial kit available! You can pre-order a Solid-ish design roll from Kimberly by contacting her at Kimberly@kimberlyeinmo.com. Each design roll contains 40 – 2½" strips and costs \$35 (including tax, payable at time of class). All you'll need to complete the quilt are two background fabrics!

- **Precision Precuts Ruler or EZ Jelly Roll Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo. Rulers will be available in class at a discount. (You can use another rotary cutting ruler, but it must have a 45-degree line.)
- 45 or 60 mm Rotary cutter. Splurge on a new blade for class!
- Cutting mat; 12" or larger recommended.
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- BSS including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable!



Quilt size: 67" x 67"
Skill level: Intermediate

***Note: Borders, backing, batting and binding not necessary to bring to class.*

FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
1 Solid-ish Design Roll or 40 – 2½" strips	2½ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20 different fabrics, 2 of each color.
Light background fabric (White)	1¼ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 3 – 5¼" strips; subcut 18 – 5¼" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 36 A triangles. • Cut 3 – 6¾" strips; subcut 18 – 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 36 B triangles.
Dark background fabric (Black)	2¾ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 3 – 5¼" strips; subcut 18 – 5¼" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 36 A triangles. • Cut 3 – 6¾" strips; subcut 18 – 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 36 B triangles. • **Cut 8 – 5½" strips and piece together for borders.
Backing	4¼ yds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • **2 panels 36" x 76"
Batting		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • **76" x 76"
Binding	¾ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • **Cut 8 – 2¼" strips; piece together to make binding.
