# Hidden Pines

This fun-to-make quilt combines nifty rotary cutting and piecing techniques using Kimberly's **EZ Flying Geese Ruler**. The surprise is the pines are 'hidden' in pieced blocks which don't look like trees until you set the blocks together! Kimberly will show you her signature method to make the star-in-a-star block with *no math, no wasted fabric* and *no stress* and your "hidden pine" blocks will complete this clever quilt. The pine blocks "turn the corner" of the quilt perfectly spaced with ease! This original design will look great with any fabrics including traditional prints, batiks, Kimberly's Solid-ish line, and especially in Christmas colors!

## Supply List

- **EZ Flying Geese Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo.
- **EZ Jelly Roll Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo **or Precision Precuts Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo, optional but helpful.
- 45 or 60 mm Rotary cutter.
- Cutting mat, larger than 12" square.
- Post It Notes, helpful in class but optional.
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread in a neutral color.
- Basic sewing supplies.

## Fabric Requirements and Instructions

- Instructions are written for the **EZ Flying Geese and EZ Jelly Roll Rulers** and are necessary for class.
- Cut all strips selvage to selvage / width of fabric (WOF).
- Bring all fabric to class.
- Abbreviations:
  - **EZFG** – **EZ Flying Geese Ruler**
  - **EZJR** – **EZ Jelly Roll Ruler**
  - **RSU** – **right side up**
  - **RSD** – **right side down**

## Fabric Cutting Chart --- bring all fabric and strips to class!

LEGEND	FABRIC #	YARDS	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
	<b>1 – Background</b>	• 7/8 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 2 – 4½" strips; subcut ONLY 8 – 4½" squares and bring remaining strips.</li> <li>• Cut 7 – 2½" strips.</li> </ul>
	<b>2 – Inner star</b>	• ¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 4½" strip; subcut 1 – 4½" square. Trim remaining fabric strip to 2½" and bring to class.</li> </ul>
	<b>3 – Outer star and border</b>	• 1 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 4½" strip.</li> <li>• Cut 1 – 2½" strip.</li> <li>• Cut 4 – 4½" strips; set aside for outer border.</li> </ul>
	<b>4 – Inner trees</b>	• ¼ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 2 – 2½" strips.</li> </ul>
	<b>5 – Outer trees</b>	• ½ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 4 – 2½" strips.</li> </ul>
	<b>6 – Binding</b>	• 3/8 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• **Cut 5 – 2¼" strips; piece together for binding.</li> </ul>

\*\* Not necessary to bring to class.
