- Sky 3/4 yard
- Hills fat quarter each lt and Med lt greens
- Foreground fat quarter
- Dress fat quarter pale lavender
- Leaves 3 fat quarters
- Stems 3 fat quarters bright greens
- Assorted Fat eights for hat, flowers dress trim
