

“Machine Quilting Free Motion 101”

SUPPLY LIST

#1 Supply: Sewing Machine in good working order that you are familiar with. \ *Please bring instruction manual to class if available.*
Machine must have ability to “drop feed dogs” or “adequately cover the feed dogs in good working condition.

Basic:

- Scissors
- A hand needle-any size sharp will be fine as long as the eye is big enough to feed the quilting thread through
- A pack of new quilting needles for your machine size 75/11 (recommend Schmetz brand needles)
- Open Toe Embroidery, Free Motion Embroidery, or Free Motion Quilting Foot, must have SPRING MOTION!
- 2 Pencils Sharpened

Fabric:

- Nine 13”-14” square “quilt sandwiches”- composed of solid fabric on top, cotton or cotton mixed batting and either muslin or light solid for backing

Thread:

- 1 spool of 40 wt or finer machine quilting thread. **Fill to bobbins prior to class!**

Optional:

- Rubber Filing Fingers or Cotton Rubber Grip Gloves or any other item that you use for machine quilting

Quilt Guild: White copy paper for drawing...at least 5-7 sheets per student-due to weight restrictions in air travel I ask that you supply this item. **IMPORTANT!**
