

# "Glorious"

Placemats & table runner/wall hanging from the book, Flip Flop Block Quilts, published by AQS, release date October 2010.



## SET UP

Placemats (2) 16" x 21 1/2"

Table runner 18" x 35 1/2"

Total # of Blocks Needed = 22

6 for each placemat

10 for table runner

Total # of Rows:

2 x 3 = placemat

2 x 5 = table runner

Borders:

One border on each piece

Measurement = 3" at deepest width for placemats; 3 3/4" for table runner/wallhanging

Fabric/Yardage Requirements:

110 strips @ 7" x 1 1/2" of at least 30 different black & white fabrics -- 3/3/4 yds of 1/8's

220 strips @ 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" RED (2 pieces for each block) -- 3/8 yd

220 strips @ 1 1/2" x 4" B&W (2 pieces for each block) -- 3/8 yd



Construct your individual blocks by sewing 7" strips together. All strips will be 1 1/2" wide and 7" long. The pieced strips with the highlighting red fabric in the middle of the block will be RED = 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" and BLACK & WHITE 1 1/2" x 4". When you have seven strips sewn together, you will use your FFB to cut the outside of the block into a curve.

THEN FOLLOW BASIC CONSTRUCTION DIRECTIONS TO SEW YOUR ROWS TOGETHER.  
ADD BORDERS AND QUILT AND BIND.
